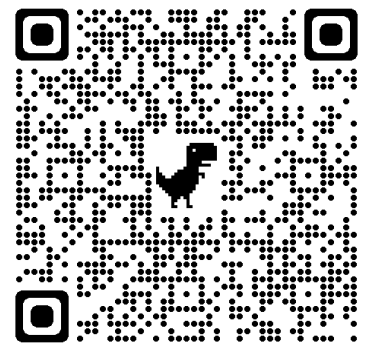

Subject Leaders Network

- allow the technicians to conduct their needs analysis and therefore inform any SLP CPD and or bespoke programmes that can support you in your departments.
