The key functions of our Teaching School Hub

Initial Teacher Training

The DfE require Teaching School Hubs to support ITT in two ways;

- to provide ITT programmes
- to support local ITT delivery across their TSH area, focussing on building an understanding of school engagement in ITT in their area and supporting school engagement in ITT, both for school placements and intensive training and practice

Appropriate Body services

- Deliver Appropriate Body services to ensure that Early Career Teachers have access to appropriate support and training

Early Career Teachers

- Deliver the ECTP in partnership with a lead provider

National Professional Qualifications

- Deliver National Professional Qualifications in partnership with a lead provider

Provision for Early Career Teachers

Appropriate Body services

OneCornwall is the Appropriate Body (AB) service for Cornwall and have significant experience in offering a high-quality service and central point of contact for all schools and Early Career Teachers (ECTs) in Cornwall. We provide a standardised approach across the region that is consistent yet personalised to meet the needs of all schools and their ECTs.

All schools that offer a statutory induction are required to have an AB for their ECTs. AB's play a key role in statutory teacher induction. In addition to monitoring that ECT's receive their statutory entitlements, AB's will support schools and ECT's to meet the statutory guidance with:

- full access to OneCornwall TSH AB services
- AB registration of ECTs on the Teacher Regulation Agency system and ECT manager
- regular checks of monitoring reports and formal assessment points at the end of year 1 and 2 of induction
- additional support for ECTs not meeting Teachers' Standards

OneCornwall offers a provider led programme, delivering the Early Career Teacher Programme (ECTP) in partnership with Teach First or The National Institute of Teaching. This is the route that the majority of schools in Cornwall.

Early Career Framework

Delivery of the Early Career Framework (ECTP) for teachers in years 1 & 2 of their careers.

OneCornwall is an ECF Provider for Cornwall and has significant proven experience in offering a high-quality service for schools and ECT's. We offer a standardised approach across the region and can also offer a MAT approach for your ECT's induction, which is personalised to meet the needs of all schools/MATs and their ECT(s).

OneCornwall offers a Full Induction Programme, delivering the ECTP in partnership with Teach First or the National Institute of Teaching. The ECF is delivered by experienced teachers and leaders, through a mixture of face to face and online delivery. This is the route that the majority of schools take in Cornwall.

The offer for Early Career Teachers includes:

- 2 years of funded, high quality training through the ECTP
- funding 10% timetable reduction in year 1 and 5% time away from the classroom for teachers in their second year
- a dedicated mentor and support for mentors
- funding to cover mentors' time with the ECT in the first and second year of teaching

For the early headship coaching offer, funding to cover the course fees will be available if you are in your first 5 years of headship in England in a state-funded school or state-funded 16 to 19 organisation. You should also be doing or have done the headship NPQ.

Eligibility for NPQ programmes

OneCornwall can support you in checking your eligibility for an NPQ programme, you may meet the funding criteria but not the course eligibility.

Supporting our ITT providers

OneCornwall support ITT provider connection/collaboration through our Cornwall ITT provider network. The network is working to improve recruitment and retention by sharing our expertise.

We are working together to ensure that we promote Cornwall as a destination to train and work. Our network ensures that we have a local offer for all routes into teaching.

Teach Cornwall

In addition to this our network is developing a 'Teach Cornwall' strategy

- working with Marjon university, exploring interventions to improve recruitment/retention in rural/coastal areas
- developing a countywide school experience programme (ITT applicants/Post-16/HEI placements)
- working to improve recruitment to shortage subjects (secondary)
- supporting the transition from ITT to ECT

Is your school engaged in Initial Teacher Training?

You can get involved in training the next generation of Cornwall's teachers

- offering school placements
- supporting the delivery of Intensive Training and Practice (ITaP)
- engaging in delivery on ITT programmes
